

# OID Board To Discuss Delivery Standards

The Oakdale Irrigation District's Board of Directors will conduct two special sessions to review its irrigation and water delivery service standards and potential improvement projects as part of the District's Water Resources Plan, beginning tonight, Aug. 10, at the Rama Inn.

The Aug. 10 will focus on the district service standards, according to OID General Manager Steve Knell, who announced the workshops. The board will review current and proposed practices as they relate to water deliveries to its customers.

The public is invited to both sessions, which will be conducted in the conference

room at the Rama Inn, located at 1450 East F St. Meetings are scheduled to begin at 6 p.m.

On Aug. 17, the session will focus on potential improvement projects that would enhance OID's service to customers. Knell said the board will review various options that will be presented by CH2M Hill, a water resources planning firm retained by the irrigation district to conduct its Water Resources Plan study.

Knell said the plan will help guide OID for the next 20 years as it considers how to protect its water rights, enhance district services and repair and upgrade its infrastructure.
